- 4 Existing tessilated tile and bluestone paving to verandah to be retained (new stair entry to be constructed to approved future detail)
- 5 Residents sculpture
- 6 Existing Lamp Post to be retained
- 7 Existing Lawn Area to be regraded (retaining wall & existing trees to be removed)
- 8 Existing School Bell to be retained
- 9 Continuation of Quercus canariensis as per Lower Drive at 15m Centre
- 10 Low Key Native Tree Planting & Associated Carparking
- 11 Gravel paving with Ag pipes
